



Parent Single Sign-On Information

- If you do not have a PowerSchool login and password, see the designated school personnel at your child's school to obtain an initial PowerSchool login and password.
- To access the Parent Portal, go to:
<http://powerschool.anderson2.k12.sc.us/public/>
- Parents have to have a login and password in PowerSchool in order to create an account for Single Sign-On.
- If two people want separate accounts, both parties have to have the login and password of the parent/guardian that has the current login now in order to create a separate login.
- When new students are entered into PowerSchool, the parent login has to be created in PowerSchool and given to the parent for them to create a parent account.

Create a Parent Account

A parent account allows you to view the information for one or more students with a single sign in. You can also manage your personal account preferences.

To create a parent account, enter the following information:

- **Name** - Your first and last name
- **Email** - Student notifications and correspondence related to your parent account will be sent to this email
- **Desired Username** - Your username is your unique PowerSchool identity
- **Password** - Your password must be at least 6 characters long
- **Student Access Information** - Information for a minimum of one student, including the student name, Access ID, Access Password, and your relationship to the student

* Access ID: Enter current Parent/Guardian login
 ** Access Password: Enter current Parent/Guardian password

***The Link Students to Account section must be completed for all of your children at each school.
