

Public Notice (for website)

In compliance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 (AHERA), Anderson County School Districts are required annually to inform all students and their parents/guardians, all school system employees and volunteers, and any other building occupants, of the potential presence of asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) within the school district facilities.

Each school facility constructed prior to 1990 has a written Asbestos Management Plan on site to document:

- a. the location and condition of the ACBM within the facility,
- b. the laboratory reports of sampled building materials,
- c. the abatement and removal projects, and
- d. the required surveillance and reinspection reports.

Also included as part of the Management Plan is a written Operations and Maintenance Guideline that is required to maintain the ACBM within the facility in a safe, non-hazardous manner. This Management Plan is available for review during normal business hours at the District Offices and copies are available for a fee.

Due to extensive asbestos abatement projects, demolition of older school buildings, and the construction of newer facilities, some school buildings have been deemed to be asbestos-free structures. Any remaining ACBM will continue to be inspected every six months for potential damage and/or subsequent repair or removal.
